

A sthe U.A.E. healthcare sector is set to continue its impressive growth in the coming decades, opportunities for new U.S.-U.A.E. partnerships abound. A joint venture between the U.A.E.'s Mubadala Investment Company and the U.S.-based Cleveland Clinic Foundation, the 364-bed multidisciplinary, physician-led hospital brings an unparalleled level of specialized care.

As a result, chronic conditions such as diabetes, cardiovascular diseases, and cancer are increasingly prevalent. 11 Heart disease accounts for 37% of all fatalities in Abu Dhabi, according to 2016 statistics from the Department of Health – Abu Dhabi. Cancer is also a big killer, accounting for 15% of deaths.12 Diabetes is also a problem, with a 2017 survey by the Dubai Health Authority finding that 19% of Emiratis in Dubai are diabetic.

Cardiovascular disease is the leading cause of death in the UAE, where it accounts for 41 percent of all mortalities. Treatment for cardiovascular disease is expected to account for 24 percent of the total healthcare expenditure in 2025, compared to less than 12 percent of the total expenditure today.

Alarmingly, the age of cardiovascular disease/heart attack occurrence is dropping dramatically. Lifestyle choices are leading to an increase in heart conditions in patients under the age of 40 attributed to widespread smoking, a sedentary lifestyle, high blood pressure, high cholesterol, obesity, stress, and a family (genetic) disposition. Whereas the global average age of a heart attack is 50 to 65 years old, the UAE average is 45 to 55 years old.

The healthcare market in the UAE is projected at \$19.5 billion in 2020, indicating an annual average growth of 12.7 percent from 2015. The outpatient and inpatient markets are projected to reach \$12.1 billion and \$7.5 billion, respectively, in 2020. The country is likely to see a nearly 3 percent annual increase in the number of hospital beds required, presenting a demand of more than 13,800 beds by 2020. In 2014, Dubai spent \$3.5 billion on healthcare, of which the private sector accounted for 66.6 percent. From Virginia Economic Development Partnership – International Trade UAE Healthcare Industry 7 2012, the overall healthcare spending grew by 27.7 percent and that in the private sector increased by 37 percent.

The Global Cardiovascular Devices Market was valued at \$32.8 billion in 2018 and is forecast to grow at a modestxx.3 % CAGR between 2018 and 2026, culminating in 2026 global sales of \$68.2 billion.

Dubai is one of the seven Emirates (expresses) that consolidated in 1971 to frame the United Arab Emirates (UAE). Alternate individuals are Abu Dhabi (the capital), Ajman, Fujairah, Ras Al Khaimah, Sharjah and Umm Al Quwain (every Emirate is named after its principle city).

Good business conditions and wise speculation choices have prompted Dubai getting to be one of the Gulf's best and quickly growing monetary situations and Dubai is currently immovably settled as the business, money related and business centre of the locale.

Atmosphere

The atmosphere in Dubai is dry, subtropical and rain is extremely uncommon.

The most sweltering months are amongst June and September when the temperature frequently best 45 to 50°C amid the day and the stickiness is high. The temperature of the sea can achieve 37°C at the most sweltering piece of the mid year. Inn pools are cooled in the mid year and warmed in the winter.

The climate in October, November and April offer more sensible temperatures of in the vicinity of 30°C and 35°C, however the best time to visit Dubai is between the long stretches of December and March, when the temperature is pleasurable and the warm waters and sybaritic spas are certain to have the best impact, when the normal temperature is 24°C.

Allowed Items

Travelers are allowed to bring the accompanying things into Dubai International Airport without paying traditions obligation: Gifts whose esteem does not surpass AED 3,000 The Number of cigarettes might not surpass 400 cigarettes, 50 stogies, 500 grams of tobacco (minced or squeezed for channels), minced or squeezed tobacco for smoking, tobacco or gentle tasting tobacco, The measure of mixed drink and lager should not surpass 4 liters of liquor refreshments; or 2 containers of brew (each comprising of 24 jars, not surpassing 355 ml for each can or its comparable), Still and moving picture camcorders with their suitable tapes, movies and frill, Projectors for showing slides and movies including embellishments and pleasant amounts of slides and movies, Telescopes, Portable music types of gear, Radio frameworks, consolidated telecom device, CD and DVD players with pleasant amounts, Mobile phone Portable TV sets, Portable writing sets, Computers including workstations, Portable number crunchers, Baby autos, Disabled wheelchairs and autos, Sports hardware, cash, monetary standards and explorers checks not as much as AED 40,000; and the traveler's age might not be under 18 years of age.

Climate:

The climate in Dubai is dry, subtropical and rain is very rare. The hottest months are between June and September when the temperature often tops 45 to 50°C during the day and the humidity is very high. The temperature of the ocean can reach 37°C at the hottest part of the summer. Hotel pools are cooled in the summer and heated in the winter. The weather in October, November and April offer more reasonable temperatures of between30°C and 35°C, but the best time to visit Dubai is between the months of December and March, when the temperature is pleasurable and the warm waters and sybaritic spas are sure to have the greatest effect, when the average temperature is 24°C.

Currency: Dirham (AED)

Dining: The restaurants are in the city various enclaves that provide hubs of varying restaurants and one of these is 'Century Village' which is an absolute must-see on any visitor's list and is located right next door to the 'Irish village'. It is a small oasis of fine dining restaurants in a relaxing atmosphere of fountains and greenery.

For Indian cuisine perhaps no better choice could be made than by visiting 'Ashiana'. It is one of the most famous and most highly respected Indian restaurants and provides Northern Indian specialities. Situated in the Sheraton Dubai Hotel and Towers, it offers a very convivial ambience, whether for business or pleasure, service is excellent and waiters are more than willing to recommend speciality dishes. The evening sees the appearance of the equally famous Ashiana resident band which enhances the ambience with the enchanting sound of classical Indian music. For a languorous meal of Lebanese and Middle Eastern cuisine, the visitor must indulge his taste buds with a visit to 'AL Qasr' found in Dubai Marine Beach Resort and Spa, its privileged position overlooks the beautifully landscaped garden, swimming

pools, and the beach. The culinary delights are accompanied by belly dancers and Arabic music, providing the perfect Arabian dream.

Shopping:

Shopping centres in Dubai form a major portion of the city's skyline. You can see a plethora of skyscrapers vying for their own little space in the all-encompassing sky. Most tourists from across the globe come here lured by the thrill and amusement of shopping in Dubai. Dubai's shopping centres are perpetually swarming with locals and tourists on Dubai tours. Sprinkled all across the emirate, Dubai shopping centres have been giving strong competition to the prime shopping destinations like Singapore, New York, Paris, etc. Second to none in their architectural magnificence, these Dubai shopping market have become some of the biggest tourist attractions of Dubai.
