MARKET ANALYSIS

Gynecology and Obstetrics, sometimes known as "The Science of Women," focuses on the female reproductive system, including puberty, pregnancy, delivery, postpartum, and menopause. From the first stage through the menopausal period and beyond, gynecologists and obstetricians must deal with a wide range of challenges. Gynecologists often conduct treatments such dilation and curettage, hysterectomy, oophorectomy, tubal hysteroscopy, diagnostic laparoscopy, appendectomy, and cervical excision, all of which present a number of obstacles. Additionally, they had to calmly perform the risky process of birthing as well as treat both acute and chronic medical disorders. The worldwide gynecologic device market is set to reach \$2.1 billion in 2021, with mechanical uterine tissue removal devices experiencing the highest rise in demand. Despite COVID19, it is anticipated that the size of the worldwide market would rise during the projection period and surpass \$3.3 billion in 2027.

According to investigations, there were 160 maternal fatalities attributable to COVID-19, which have been reported globally, with the majority occurring in middle-income countries and acting as a barrier to the reduction of maternal mortality. Recent investigations from Sweden and the US have shown that pregnant and perinatal women are being put under increased risk of technical hitches associated with COVID-19, contrary to initial studies that suggested pregnant women were not at a higher risk of complications due to COVID - 19 infection. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) observed a greater risk of ICU admission and mechanical breathing compared to non-pregnant women in an examination of 8207 COVID-19 cases in the obstetric population, even though a higher risk of death could not be determined. As part of a sustainable development goal, lower the worldwide maternal death rate to around 70 per 100,000 live births between 2021 and 2030.



ABOUT VENUE

Paris is the capital and largest city of France. In a northern bend of the Seine in north-central France, the two islands Île Saint-Louis and the larger Île de la Cité make up the oldest part of Paris. The normal oceanic climate of Western Europe is affected by the North Atlantic Current in Paris. All year long, the climate is pleasant and moderately humid. Paris has long been one of Europe's primary centres for commerce, diplomacy, fashion, science, and the arts. Among the most visited sites in downtown Paris are The Louvre, Sainte-Chapelle, and Notre-Dame Cathedral. On the left bank, southwest of the city, lie Les Invalides, home to Napoleon's grave, and the Eiffel Tower. Paris has drawn artists from all over the world for centuries, who flock to the city to train and find inspiration in its extensive collection of creative resources and galleries. As a result, Paris earned the moniker "City of Art." Particularly in sculpture and reliefs, Italian painters had a significant impact on the growth of art in Paris in the 16th and 17th century. During the French Baroque and Classical eras, when painting and sculpture were the glory of the French monarchy, the French royal family hired several Parisian painters to beautify their palaces.
