North America remains dominant, with Asia-Pacific experiencing rapid growth due to rising healthcare investments.

Projected to grow from \$12 billion in 2022 to \$16 billion by 2028 at a 5-6% CAGR, the market is fueled by advancements in AI, telemedicine, and active wound care products, alongside a shift toward home and specialty care settings.


